Job Title: Rugby Coach

### Purpose of Job:

The primary role and responsibility for the rugby coach, is to assist the PE team in delivering high quality PE/Rugby sessions. Our Rugby coach will work alongside PE teachers to coach our highly regarded rugby union teams in Years 7 to 13. The successful candidate will be required to work flexibly, supporting Saturday fixtures as appropriate.

- Working closely with the Head of PE and PE department, coaching rugby union to years 7 13.
- Supporting the creation and development of a girls rugby team.
- Taking teams for fixtures.
- Assist in the administration and smooth running of the department; Administrative tasks such as inputting fixtures onto SOCS, etc.
- Assisting in PE lessons & Applied Resilience Lessons.
- Supporting strength and conditioning sessions for students.
- Supporting our sporting enrichment offer.
- The Role will require you to be flexible and at times you will need to use your initiative to
  proactively offer assistance to members of the department. You may also be required to carry out
  any other reasonable requests made.
